

The Budget Hearing for the City of Norton was held in the Municipal Court Room on June 14, 1974 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Fulks presiding.

Mayor Fulks called the meeting to order and appointed City Manager, Milas Franks as Acting Clerk for the budget hearing.

Mayor Fulks then asked if anyone present had any questions or comments about the proposed budget.

Anita D. Steiner, Chairman of Planning District 1 Mental Health and Mental Retardation Services Board, appeared before Council and requested a committment of \$1,853.00 as local committment from the City of Norton for administration and operating costs of Planning District 1 Mental Health and Mental Retardation Services Board for fiscal year 1974-75. 6585


Mayor Fulks instructed the City Manager to read the synopsis of the budget for fiscal year 1974-75.
