

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on May 15, 1973, with Mayor Fulks presiding.

Also Present: Milas Franks, City Manager & Montie Meeks, City Attorney

Mrs. Edwards representing her father, John Leho, Sr. appeared before council regarding closing of 8th Street joining her property. Council discussed this matter with Mrs. Edwards and advised her they would look at this street on Friday, May 18th. 6306

On motion by Jim Humphreys, seconded by W.F. McElroy and carried by unanimous roll call vote council moved that resolution between L. & N. Railroad Company and City of Norton for sewer easement be passed. (Insert) 6307

On motion by Robert Leonard, seconded by Jim Humphreys and carried by unanimous roll call vote council moved that the following ordinance regarding water & sewer connection charges be adopted on first reading with amendment in parenthesis (in excess of Fifty Feet) 6308

On motion by Jim Humphreys, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous roll call vote council moved that the following ordinance adopting Water & Sewer Rates be passed on first reading. (Insert) 6309

On motion by Jim Humphreys, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous vote council moved that second reading of above ordinance be held at next regular council meeting. 6310

Mr. Franks advised council the School Board would like a budget work session with them at 7:30 P.M. Friday. Council was in agreement for this meeting. 6311

Council agreed to meet at 7 00 P.M. Friday to take a look at the Leho Property on 8th Street with regarding to closing street. 6312

The City Manager advised council that the Norton Housing Authority had requested a joint meeting at 4:00 P.M. Friday at the Housing Office to discuss a proposed site development that the Fleming Land Company has prepared for the development of old coke yard. 6313

Mr. Franks discussed with council the City Landfill. He advised council that effective July 1, 1973 the City had been notified that they will be expected to comply with State Regulations. Council discussed this matter at length after which they instructed Mr. Franks to request Mr. Olin Willis, to come before council to discuss this matter with them. 6314

Council instructed the City Manager to inquire as to central Landfills in surrounding communities to see if they are operating in compliance with the State Laws. 6315

Councilman McElroy inquired of over-expenditure in the budget for Little League Field. Council discussed this matter briefly after which City Attorney advised he would report back to council meeting next month regarding the mechanical lien against the project. 6316

Mayor Fulks presented a request for maintenance work on 12th Street to be done between Gas Station and Moon Mullins property at Kentucky Avenue in Ramsey. 6317

Si Ingram advised council that a fire extinguisher in hall at Burton High School, had not been checked since 1970. 6318

Mayor Fulks advised council that work on the Clear Creek Recreation Area was in progress.
