

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on August 7, 1973 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Fulks presiding.

Minutes of the previous meeting ^{was} read and approved.

Mr. Fred Forberg, Director of Appraisal & Mapping Division of State Dept. of Taxation appeared before council and discussed plans for General Reassessment of City of Norton Real Estate. 6360

Mr. Ralph Rasnick appeared before council regarding status of proposed endorsement by City Council of Emergency Medcial Service Communication System. Council instructed the City Attorney and City Manager to work up resolution for council to act upon at next council meeting, also to get adjusted cost estimate. 6361

Mayor Fulks inquired as to what had been done regarding Old Lay property. Mr. Franks advised they were in the process of securing correct addresses of owners. 6362

Mayor Fulks inquired of News Reporter Gregg Edwards status of resolution on vandalism. 6363

The City Manager advised that Mobile Cannery is going to be under county operation. 6364

On motion by Jim Humphreys, seconded by Robert Leonard and carried by unanimous roll call vote council moved that Mr. John Franklin be reappointed as member of City of Norton Planning Commission for a four year term, said term to expire July 31, 1977. 6365

Mr. Franks discussed with council city owned property at back of old elementary school. On motion by Roy Roberts, seconded by Jim Humphreys and carried by unanimous vote council instructed the City Manager to have above mentioned property torn down and lot cleaned and put in shape for recreation facility. 6366

Mr. Franks advised council of the City's annual picnic scheduled for August 25th at Flag Rock 1:00 P.M. 6367

Mr. Franks discussed P.A. System for court room with council. Council authorized the City Manager to go ahead and have it installed at a price not to exceed \$740.65. 6368

Mr. Franks advised council of Municipal League Convention to be held in Norfolk on September 16, 17, 18, 1973. 6369

5. County Water customers.


