

A special meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on February 10, 1969, at 4:00 p.m. with Vice Mayor Hunnicutt presiding.

Vice Mayor Hunnicutt announced that nominations for appointment of City of Norton School Board members were in order.

On motion by S.H. Neeley, seconded by W.G. Stallard and carried by unanimous vote, council moved that W.P. Kanot be appointed as member of City of Norton School Board to fill the unexpired term of R.A. Sult, resigned, said term to expire June 30, 1969.

Vice Mayor Hunnicutt announced that the next item on the agenda was appointment of representative on the Duffield Industrial Corporation. Council discussed this matter at length. Attorney Stump was asked to look into matter as to whether or not a city employee could serve as a member of this Corporation. Council decided to hold this matter in abeyance until they hear from local industrial corporation as to their recommendation for an appointment.

Council discussed briefly Mr. Norton's need for someone to help in government programming.

Councilman Neeley brought to council's attention need for having policement at ball games. Council suggested that Mr. Norton discuss this matter with Mr. Gardner to see what can be worked out.
