

October 17, 1968

A special called meeting of City Council was held in the Municipal Building on October 17, 1968 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Flanary presiding.

Present: V.O. Flanary, G.E. Hunnicutt, R.L. Collins, S.H. Neeley, W.G. Stallard

Also Present: Evan Norton, City Manager & Robert Winston, Attorney

Council discussed at length change in parking meters. Mr. Kidd, President of Greater Norton, Inc. advised Council that they will have an answer regarding method of giving their customers free parking by Tuesday. Matter tabled. #4607

Council discussed financial status of Rescue Squad Building and cost of having building so that Rescue Squad will be able to operate from said location. On motion by S.H. Neeley, seconded by G.E. Hunnicutt and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that \$3,200.00 be borrowed from Flag Rock Recreation Fund to complete necessary work and that Mr. Norton be instructed to supervise completion of this job as stated within this figure. #4608

Mr. Norton advised Council that more information will be secured regarding ambulance service by November 5th. #4609

Council requested City Manager to contact other parking meter companies for quotations on parking meters. #4610

Council discussed covering of Benges Branch. On motion by S.H. Neeley, seconded by W.G. Stallard and carried by the following votes, Council moved that the City Manager be authorized to fix overpass or bridge to entrance to Garment Factory; and, that the money be appropriated from the Street Department. V.O. Flanary, R.L. Collins, S.H. Neeley, W.G. Stallard \*YEAH; G.E. Hunnicutt \*not voting. #4611

Mr. Norton advised Council of meeting with Lenowisco and HUD Officials, Thursday November 7th at 9:00 A.M. This is to be a joint meeting with Planning Commission and Housing and Redevelopment Authority. #4612

Council agreed to have regular Council meeting on November 6th at 7:30 P.M. due to Election on November 5th. #4613

Mr. Norton presented recommendation of Housing Authority for appointment of W.F. McElroy to fill the unexpired term of Charles Schellenger. On motion by W.G. Stallard, seconded by S.H. Neeley and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that the recommendation of the Housing Authority for appointment of W.F. McElroy to fill the unexpired term of Charles Schellenger, said term to expire 1/28/71. #4614

Mr. Norton advised Council of meeting of School Board October 22 at 7:30 P.M. #4615

Mayor Flanary brought to Council's attention the request of Bob Whitaker and neighbors that something be done regarding the smoke and odor from Roberts Recapping Place. Matter referred to City Manager. #4616

Council also instructed the City Manager to look into the matter of similar problems at the Band Box. #4617

There being no further business to come before the Council, same adjourned.
