

January 3, 1967

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Building Court Room on January 3, 1967 at 7:00 P.M. with Mayor Flanary presiding.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Council discussed appointment of members to Industrial Development Authority. #3890

Mr. Norman presented Council with a schedule of sales tax collection. #3891

Mr. Norman presented Council with a schedule of necessary changes in school appropriation. After a lengthy discussion, Council instructed the City Manager to work out necessary changes. #3892

Council agreed to refer above bids to Councilman Collins for study of specifications.


Mr. Norman advised Council of plans to change water billing from one month to every two months. Council agreed with this change. #3896


