Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The city attorney advised council that he had discussed with Mr. George Hunnicutt regarding release agreements for accounts receivable. He stated that Mr. Hunnicutt 3549 wanted the city to put pump back into well and that he would grant them use of water if and when needed. Council instructed the city manager to get estimate of cost of putting pump back into well.

Mr. Norman advised council that as of this date he had not received all of the 3550 hospitalization insurance bids but expects to receive the remiander of them by the first of the week. He asked council what date would be convenient to meet on this subject. Council agreed on Tuesday night, February 8th.

Mayor Holbomb brought to council's attention the request of Dean Joe Smiddy of Clinch Valley College that a member of the city's governing body be present at a meeting in Richmond, February 10th, regarding the making of Clinch Valley College a four year college. Council requested that Mr. Norman attend this meeting if at all possible. Attorney Mullins advised council that he would be in attendance at this meeting.

The city manager discussed with council briefly the adding of an additional filter to the filter plant. Council instructed the city manager to go ahead and file for government grants.

Mr. Norman outlined the program of snow removal. Council discussed this program briefly with the city manager.

Mr. Norman discussed with council the increase in charge for special trash pick-up. Council agreed to make charge of minimum of \$5.00 per load or part load.

Mr. Norman advised council that representative from TVA would be here next week to discuss water flow of Benges Branch.

Mr. Nor that gave estimate of cost of 6" line to Spring Avenue. He stated that cost would be around \$1650.00 and with labor running it over \$2,000.00. Matter tabled. 3556

Mr. Norman advised council tht the insurance company for the City of Norton had 3557 requested the city to place a fence on wall beside Norton Hotel on 8th Street. Council instructed Mr. Norman to go ahead with this project, as soon as possible.

Attorney Mullins advised council that in his opinion, the city charter is broad 3558 enough to cover pollution of streams.

Council instructed the city manager to write the State Water Control Board requesting that they investigate and take care of this complaint, the stream near Roundtown Bridge.3559
