November 1, 1966

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on November 1, 1966 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Flanary presiding.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Dr. Charles Litton appeared before Council in behalf of Greater Norton, Inc., requesting consideration and assistance regarding additional parking facilities for the City of Norton. Council advised Mr. Litton of a Planning Commission meeting to be held on November 14th with State Officials and suggested that they have a representative present to discuss this matter. Council assured Dr. Litton that much consideration will be given to this matter.

#3829 Mr. W.R. Hammer, together with a group of citizens of Hammer Avenue, appeared before Council requesting completion of work on Hamner Avenue. After a discussion of this matter, Council instructed the City Manager to have the engineering problem solved so that work can be completed.

"Red" Trinkle, Chairman of the Grievance Committee of the Norton Volunteer Fire #3830 Department, appeared before Council requesting resolution to be passed by Council to amend the Code of the City of Norton so that the Fire Department may continue to elect all officers of the Fire Department. After a lengthy discussion, with several members of the Department expressing their views on the subject, no action was taken.

Mr. C.B. Porter appeared before Council regarding sewage stoppage in front of his property of Virginia Ave. Matter referred to City Manager.

On motion by S.H. Neeley, seconded by R.L. Collins and carried by unanimous #3832 vote, the Dog Ordinance was passed on second reading. (See Page 22, #3813 of Minute Book)

Mrs. N.H. Short and Mr. Hoge Horne appeared before Council regarding John Street.#3833 After discussion of this matter, Attorney Mullins advised Council of the previous court action on this property.

Mr. Horne advised Council that a garbage dump is being made of John Street. Matter referred to City Manager.

Mr. Norman discussed with the Council the matter of raising overtime parking to \$.50. Matter tabled until next Council meeting.

Mr. Norman brought to Council request for \$250.00 for Cumberland Brochure. On motion by S.H. Neeley, seconded by C.W. Bryant and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council granted approval of request for \$250.00 for Cumberland Brochure.

A brief discussion was held of location of Route #23. Mr. Norman advised that as yet he had not received an answer to his letter requesting the Highway Department for public hearing on relocation of Route #23.

Mr. Norman advised Council that plans are being made for enforcement of Dog Ordinance.

The City Manager advised Council that the City did not have to borrow any money during the past month.

City Manager advised Council that the T V Cable Service had indicated that they are making plans to install their own poles for service to Ramsey.
