

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on August 3, 1965 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Holcomb presiding.

Present: J.C. Holcomb, Archie Woods, V.O. Flanary, C.W. Bryant, R.L. Collins

Also Present: David Norman, City Manager and R.T. Winston, Attorney.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Mr. W.P. K^Anto appeared before council and presented a letter from Mr. Anderson of the State Health Department regarding the inspection of filtration plant in July. He discussed this letter briefly with council. Mr. Kanto advised council that Mr. Cavanaugh would be here Monday, August 9th to discuss the lime feeding machine with the city. Mr. Kanto presented averages of water accountability for the past two years after which he stressed the importance of a leak survey. He recommended to council that the city use their forces to take a leak survey with the equipment they have on hand. If this does not prove successful, he recommends they have a leak survey made by a competent company. 2483

Council instructed the city manager to proceed with this program.

C.L. Marcum, Commissioner of Revenue, appeared before council stressing the need for a remapping or updating of the city maps. 2483

Council instructed the city manager to take this matter up with Mr. Curry of the Remapping Section of the Department of Taxation.

On motion by C.W. Bryant, seconded by V.O. Flanary and carried by unanimous vote council appointed Mr. David Norman as a member of the City Board of Public Welfare for a period of August 1, 1965 to November 21, 1966. 2483

On motion by C.W. Bryant, seconded by R.L. Collins and carried by unanimous vote council appointed Mr. David Norman as a member of Norton Planning & Zoning Commission, said term to expire July 31, 1967. 2484

Mayor Holcomb reported on delinquent taxes collected for month of July, 1965 taxes \$908.35; penalty & interest \$67.83 or a total of \$976.18. 2485

George Hunnicutt appeared before council and asked if there had been any action regarding moving of swimming pool from its present location. Council advised Mr. Hunnicutt that no official action had been taken. 2486

Council instructed Mr. Winston, City Attorney, to check into the matter of city being able to seal the property on which the swimming pool is located.

On motion by R.L. Collins, seconded by Archie Woods and carried by unanimous vote the following resolution was passed: 2487

Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Norton, Virginia, that David Norman, City Manager be authorized to sign bonds and checks on behalf of the City of Norton and other documents that the Wise County National Bank may require, together with any other powers as granted to the city manager in the City Charter.

Mr. Flanary reported on alley back of Craig Street. He stated this alley could be opened up without much expense to the city. In his opinion a piece of pipe and approximately 1000 gallons of asphalt would be sufficient. 2488

On motion made and duly seconded council moved that Virginia Avenue, N.E. back of Park Drive-in be paved by the City and that Charlie Daniels has agreed to pay one-half cost thereof. 2489

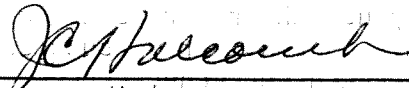
Mr. Winstead appeared before council and asked what decision they had made regarding final Federal inspection of Parts 3 & 4 of the sewage system. He stated that there

were three discrepancies which had been on the discrepancy list for three months. 2490
Council instructed Mr. Winstead that the city would be ready for final inspection
after, in his opinion, all the discrepancies were taken care of. 2491

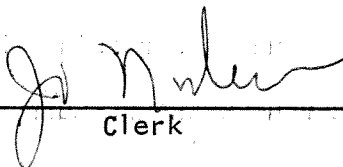
Council gave a vote of appreciation for the outstanding job Mayor Holcomb and 2491
