A special meeting of the City Council was held in the City Manager's Office on August 26, 1964, at 2:00 P.M. with Mayor B.E. Ball presiding.



After a discussion of the problems and questions related to the problem of the Ike Fultz water supply and previous actions taken by the Council, on motion by J.B. Taggart, seconded by J.C. Holcomb and carried by unanimous vote, the following resolution was passed: #282

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTON that Mr. Jester and Mr. Charles Daniels be instructed to have a proper release form prepared by the City Attorney for presentation to Mr. Ike Fultz for his signature prior to the installation, by the City, of a water tap for Mr. Fultz property. It is specifically understood that the release form to be prepared and signed will protect and release the City of Norton and Daniels Heating & Plumbing, and any other parties, from any responsibilities or liability for any damage of any sort which may result to Mr. Fultz's property, water lines, etc., from or by or as a result of his tying into the Norton Water system and using water from this system at the existing high pressures.
