

October 1, 1963

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on October 1, 1963 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor B.E. Ball presiding.

Present: B.E. Ball, J.C. Holcomb, Archie Woods

Absent: A.O. Umstead, J.B. Taggart

Also Present: C.F. Jester, City Manager & R.T. Winston, Attorney

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Jester read to council the engineer's recommendation on the sewer project bids of September 26th. #2535

Mr. Jester brought council up to date on the status of the sewer project. #2536

Mr. Jester read to council a letter from the Mayor of Sweetwater, Tennessee, regarding their policy on trick or treaters on Halloween. After a brief discussion, the matter was referred to City Manager. #2537

Mr. Woods brought to council's attention the complaints of the citizens regarding TV Cable method of collection. After a discussion, council instructed the City Manager to write a letter registering this complaint. #2538

Mr. Jester advised council of a Civil Defense meeting to be held in Bristol on October 10th. Mr. Jester advised council that he and Mr. Ball plan to attend this meeting. #2539

Mr. Jester gave a report of the delinquent tax collection and delinquent accounts for the month of September, 1963. #2540

Mr. Jester advised council that the County had appropriated \$1500.00 to capital outlay for the Wise County Public Library. He presented a request that the City match this appropriation with 13%, which amount would be \$195.00. #2541


On motion by J.C. Holcomb, seconded by Archie Woods and carried by unanimous roll call vote, council moved that \$195.00 be appropriated for Wise County Public Library, said amount to be taken from 1260 account.

Mr. Jester presented Fire Department report for the month of September, 1963 #2542

Mr. Jester asked council if they would be interested in giving consideration to a retirement system for City employees. The Mayor requested that the City Manager check with other cities of our size to see what their policy was. #2543

Mr. Jester advised council that notice had been received that the State Compensation Board will meet October 7th in the auditorium of the State Library. #2544
