A special called meeting of the City Council was held in the City Manager's Office at 1:30 P.M. on January 30, 1962.

Mayor Ball announced that the propose of this meeting was as follows:

1. For the consideration of the grouting of the clear well at the filter plant and the floor of the swimming pool., at a cost of approximately \$12,500.
2. For the consideration of the reassessment of the real estate in the City of Norton.

On motion by J.C. Holcomb, seconded by W.R. Hamner and carried by unanimous #2093 roll call vote, council moved that the City Manager be authorized to proceed with the grouting of the clear well at the filter plant and the floor of the seimming pool, at a cost of approximately \$12,500.

On motion by W.R. Hamner, seconded by B.E. Ball and carried by unanimous #2094 roll call vote, council moved that the City employ an assessor assessor assigned by the State Tax Board to make a complete reassessment of the real estate of the City of Norton as required by the Virginia Code.
