An adjourned meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on the above date at 3:00 P. M. with Mayor B. E. Ball presiding.

After an inspection of the new addition to the Municipal Building # 1870 by the council members and city manager - On motion by W. R. Hamner, seconded by A. O. Umstead and carried by unanimous roll call vote, the new addition was accepted subject to the approval of the Bureau of Medical and Nursing Facilities, Dept. of Health.

Council briefly discussed the recap of the 1961-62 budget for the #1871 City of Norton.

Mr. Norton gave brief summary to Council regarding sewage disposal plant for Norton. A lengthy discussion followed regarding the Area Development Act with regard to our sewage disposal plant.

On motion by A. O. Umstead, seconded by F. W. Glass and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Mr. W. P. Kanto and Mr. Evan Norton, City Manager were delegated to make an expense paid tour, contacting the proper officials to see what can be done regarding the above matter.

Mr. Ball asked council's permission to attend the district meeting #1872 of the City Managers in Abingdon on May 13th and 14th to obtain information on a future City Manager for Norton.

Mr. Bill Kline appeared before council regarding water rights on #1873 Lost Creek. The City Attorney was instructed to investigate this matter and report back to council at the next regular meeting of May 16, 1961.
