

January 19, 1960

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on the above date at 7:30 P. M. with Mayor B. E. Ball presiding.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Paul Bolling appeared before council requesting privilege license #1605 to operate the Sportsman Pool Room in the name of George & Frank Bolling.

On motion by Fred H. King, seconded by W. R. Hamner and Carried by unanimous vote, permission was granted for the issuance of a pool room license to George & Frank Bolling, T/A the Sportsman.

Roy S. Clair appeared before council requesting a road to his property #1606 on Atlee Street. Matter referred to City Manager.

The City Manager reported on his tour of the streets with Mr. Stallard, #1599 P21 the Postmaster.

Ruby Leho appeared before council requesting that street to her house #1607 be fixed. Referred to City Manager.

On motion by Fred King, seconded by F. W. Glass and carried by unanimous vote, the following ordinance in reference to parking on Park Avenue was passed on first reading: 1608

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTON,

That from the effective date of this Ordinance it shall be unlawful to park any vehicle on Park Avenue in said City between the intersection at 4th Street and the intersection at 11th St. between the hours of 4:00 A. M. and 6:00 A. M.

Any person, firm or association violating this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to a fine of not less than \$1.00 nor more than \$10.00.

On motion by W. R. Hamner, seconded by Fred King and carried by unanimous vote, Mr. C. W. Cooper was reappointed for a four year term to end Jan. 28, 1964, as a Commissioner of the Norton Redevelopment and Housing Authority. #1609

Mr. Norton presented a statement from City of Norton School Board #1610 showing the balance of the City of Norton's indebtedness to the City of Norton School Board, for review.

After discussion of a street sweeper for the City, council instructed #1611 Mr. Norton to go to Richmond and investigate a street sweeper which was for sale by the Carey Hall Machinery Company.
