

December 20, 1960

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on the above date at 7:30 P. M. with Mayor B. E. Ball presiding.

Present: B. E. Ball, Sol Cury, J. C. Holcomb, W. R. Hamner.
Absent: F. W. Glass

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Council held a lengthy discussion on taxis and taxi drivers. #1789

The City Manager advised council that the cost of putting a fire hydrant on Hamner Avenue would be over \$4,000. After a brief discussion of this, the following motion was introduced by A. O. Umstead, seconded by J. C. Holcomb and carried by unanimous roll call vote: #1790

Resolved that the City Manager be authorized to extend the 6" water line from Park Avenue near the Dari-Kup to the corner of Virginia Avenue and a point known as an alley, a distance of approximately 400' more or less.

After a lengthy discussion of proposed sewerage disposal plant, council decided to discuss this further at a special meeting. #1791

The City Manager advised council that he had contacted Mr. John Turner, Resident Engineer, Dept. of Highways concerning vibrations on the viaduct. #1792

Mr. Norton advised council of the status of the census. At this time the figure was 4,996. #1793

Mr. Norton advised council that the meeting of Region I Industrial Development Committee was postponed due to the weather. #1794

Mr. Norton presented taxi application for Billie Lewis Slaughter. Permission denied. #1795

Mr. George Wharton appeared before council to request the \$2600.00 budgeted for the Air Port. #1796

There being no further business before council same adjourned.
