The regular meeting of the City Council was held on the above date in the Municipal Court Room at 7:30 P. M. with Mayor B. E. Ball presiding.

All members of council were present and answered to roll call.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Emory Province, representing the Norton Fire Department, appeared before council asking permission to sponsor a carnival sometime during the year. #739

On a motion by W. R. Hamner, seconded by Sol Cury and carried by unanimous vote of all those present, the Norton Fire Department was given permission to sponsor a carnival.

The City Manager presented a review of various city trading stamp ordinances. After a brief discussion the City Manager was instructed to prepare an ordinance similar to that of the City of Roanoke with the fee of \$250.00 and not to be prorated. #740

On motion by Fred H. King, seconded by Sol Cury and carried by a unanimous vote of all those present, the City Manager was instructed to install three new street lights on Virginia Avenue in East Norton and one in Chapman Hollow. #741
