An adjourned meeting of the City Council was held at 6:30 P. M. on August 25, 1958, with Mayor B. E. Ball presiding.


Present: B. E. Ball, Sol Cury, Fred King, W.R. Hamner, A.O. Umstead

Evan Norton was appointed to act as Clerk for this meeting.

A report was made by the City Manager Norton on the status of the project for grouting and stopping leaks at the new dam. It was the concensus of opinion of the Chester Engineers and the contractor was to the effect that all the work possible had been done to correct the situation. That the leaks had been located and stopped to the greatest extent and that further work in this regard should be impracticable. In making the report the City Manager recommended also that further work in this regard be discontinued and the drillers' contract terminated at this point. #1352

On motion made and duly seconded and carried by unanimous vote, council moved that the drilling and grouting work be terminated at this point.
