

April 7, 1959

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on the above date at 7:30 P. M. with Mayor B. E. Ball presiding.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Mr. J. C. Johnston appeared before council regarding taxicab rate for license. This matter was discussed but no action was taken at this time. #1453

Dr. J. T. Phillips appeared before council regarding the open drain on his property from Henry Street to Highland Avenue. Dr. Phillips requested that each member of council look at this condition to see what action could be taken. #1454

Mrs. Sarah Dollarhyde appeared before council asking when they were going to construct steps leading to her property on Murphy Street. The City Manager advised her that this work was scheduled to be done in a couple of weeks. #1455

Elbert Bolling, E. H. Bolling and D. C. Short appeared before council expressing their disapproval of annexing Guest River. The City Manager also read a letter from Charlie Wells protesting annexation. The City Manager and City Attorney agreed to hold a public hearing in this section. #1456

George Wharton representing Cumberland Airport Commissions appeared before council requesting payment of \$3,441.86 which was the balance of appropriated funds to Airport. #1457

The new building code was presented to council. Matter deferred until next meeting. #1458




