

The continued meeting of October 7, 1986 of the City Council was held in the Council Chambers on October 13, 1986 at 7:00 P.M. with Mayor Daniels presiding.

Present: Roy Roberts, Robert Raines, Cliff Daniels, Milas Franks, William Mays

Also Present: C.R. Brown, City Manager

The Mayor preceded directly to the audience for visitors,

Mr. Steve Kearns appeared before Council requesting a temporary permit to operate a car wash on Kentucky Avenue. City Council and City Manager discussed this matter with Mr. Kearns and on motion by Milas Franks, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous vote, Council authorized the City Manager to sign and issue the temporary permit in the name of Ricky Miller for the operation of a temporary car wash. The permit will expire at the time the emergency water ordinance is lifted. (Insert) 13605

Discussion of High Pressure Sodium Vapor Lights in the City of Norton, City Council discussed this matter with the City Manager. The City Manager informed Council that sufficient funds were in the current budget to proceed on converting the City's street lights to high pressure sodium vapor. City Council gave a consensus for the City Manager to proceed with this project and to exercise his discretion in this conversion. 13606

On motion by William Mays, seconded by Robert Raines and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved to go into executive session to discuss personnel as Per 2.1-344 (A) (1) of the Code of Virginia, as Amended, and Legal Matters, as Per 2.1-344 (A) (6) of the Code of Virginia, as Amended. 13607

On motion by Milas Franks, seconded by Robert Raines, and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved they go back into regular session.

The Mayor declared council back in regular session.

The Mayor advised that there was no report on legal matters, and any nominations to Board of Zoning Appeals would be postponed until next meeting. 13608

Robert Raines nominated Jack Wallace to the Cumberland's Airport Commission for a four year term to 10-31-86.

On motion by Roy Roberts, seconded by William Mays and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved the nominations be closed. 13609

The Mayor declared Jack Wallace appointed to the Cumberland's Airport Commission for a term ending 10/31/90.

The Mayor stated there will be a special called council meeting on October 27, 1986 at 7:00 P.M. pertaining to personnel. The meeting will be held in executive session. 13610
