Also Present: C.R. Brown, City Manager, Ron Peaks, City Engineer, Ernie Ward, Finance Director, John Litton and Bill Thompson



On motion by Milas Franks and seconded by Roy Roberts, and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved to go back into regular session. 13076


