

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on January 2, 1980 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Hunnicutt presiding.

Present: George Hunnicutt, W.F. McElroy, Robert Collier, Cliff Daniels, Frank Fischer

Also Present: G.M. Newman, City Manager

Robert Bolling appeared before council asking permission for renewal of pool room license for the Sportsman and Dance Hall license for the Dance Factory.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Robert Collier and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that pool room license be granted to Robert Bolling, T/A The Sportsman.

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Council discussed dance hall license with MR. Bolling after which matter was tabled until next council meeting at which time a report would be available on operation of the dance hall. Mayor Hunnicutt ask that it be noted that he took no part in discussion of dance hall permit.

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On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Robert Collier and carried by unanimous vote, council moved that Item A-1 - Approval of Minutes; A-2 - Second reading (By Title) Industrial Waste Ordinance; A-3- Consideration - Permission to sell Surplus Laundry Equipment be approved by consent with amendment to minutes to read in paragraph 9711 "Substantive defect of deed", and paragraph 9713 to read "seconded by Mr. McElroy."

On motion by Robert Collier, seconded by W.F. McElroy and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that matter of payment to Virginia Department of Highways with Revenue Sharing Funds, instead of Community Development Funds, for Dorchester Road Project be tabled until next council meeting at which time an up-date on both accounts will be available.

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Appointment to Board of Public Welfare tabled until next council meeting.

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On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Frank Fischer and carried by unanimous roll call vote, council moved that City Manager be authorized to spend up to \$12,000 to secure building of city warehouse, formerly Royal Laundry Co., and to spend up to \$1,000.00 for builders risk insurance to cover building, said funds to be taken from contingency fund.

On motion by Robert Collier, seconded by Frank Fischer and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that City Manager be authorized to negotiate a contract with Wright Dawson with the following addendas: 1. Contract to be subject to approval of HUD; 2. Expressly understood money to come out of C.D. money rather than out of City of Norton budget as distinguished from regular C.D. Budget.

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On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Frank Fischer and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved they go into executive session to discuss pending litigation.

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On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Frank Fischer and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved they go back into regular session.

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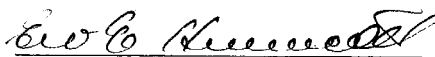
Mayor Hunnicutt declared council back in regular session

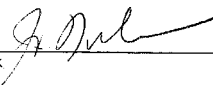
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Mayor Hunnicutt reported there was no definite action taken on pending law suit due to City Attorney not being on hand at this meeting.
