

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on August 19, 1980 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Hunnicutt presiding.

Present: George Hunnicutt, W.F. McElroy, Robert Collier, Cliff Daniels, Vic Jones

Also Present: G.M. Newman, City Manager & Kenneth Asbury, Attorney

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Robert Collier and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that minutes of previous meeting be adopted as presented.

Mr. Kenneth Hankla of 1042 Spruce Street appeared before Council requesting that consideration be given to building a sidewalk in front of his house and also storm drainage system be repaired. Council advised Mr. Hankla that consideration of sidewalks was on the agenda.

Mr. Rae Mullins of Gateway Boys Home was present and requested that the City Council approve spending of funds received from other sources than City's share in their budget. Council discussed this matter briefly with Mr. Mullins and ask that he send a complete budget to them by Mr. Kelly who is a member of their board after which they will take action on the request.

Mr. Larry Hamilton appeared before council in behalf of his father John Hamilton, former employee of the City Water Department. Mr. Hamilton outlined in detail the existing situation as he sees it, requesting that he be given pay for his 28 days of vacation which he is due and that the evaluation on his personnel records stating there had been many discrepancies found in his readings of water meters proven. Mr. Newman stated that according to personnel policy John Hamilton had taken two days over his vacation time. Council discussed this situation briefly and advised Mr. Hamilton and City Manager to get with bookkeeping and get an understanding of where he stands. Mr. Newman told Mr. Hamilton he would be glad to discuss the situation with him at any time. Mr. Hamilton stated they would rather turn the case over to a lawyer.

Mayor Hunnicutt called for report from Blue Ribbon Parking Committee. There was no report given.

9898

The City Manager discussed with council procedures for sidewalk repair. After a brief discussion council directed the City Attorney to prepare an ordinance to conform with what the policy for sidewalks is and for this matter to be placed on agenda for next council meeting.

Mr. Hankla was advised that his request for sidewalk would be considered at next council meeting.

9899

Mr. Newman presented final bill from Dept. of Highways for project on Kentucky Avenue in 1971, in amount of \$3,199.70.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Robert Collier and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that pay to Department of Highways \$3,199.70, said funds to be taken from contingency.

J.T. Caruso spoke to council briefly on parking situation in area between 5th and 6th Streets. He commented that parking seemed to be mostly by employees or business owners on that block. He requested that the City do something to relieve this situation and that parking meters remain.

On motion by Robert Collier, seconded by Cliff Daniels and carried by unanimous roll call vote, council moved that go into executive session to consider personnel matter and pending contract.

9902

On motion by Robert Collier, seconded by W.F. McElroy and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved they go back into regular session.

9903

Mayor Hunnicutt declared council back in regular session.

Mayor Hunnicutt said in consideration of appointment, Mr. Collier had names of persons to be presented for Ecology Committee: Sandy Witt, Garden Club; Bill Kelly, Police; Robbie Tate, Business; "Red" Brooks, Senior Citizen; Mark Caruso, High School; Mr. Newman, Administration; one member of council; W.F. McElroy moved that Robert Collier be appointed as representative from Council on Ecology Committee. All Councilmen voted for nominations to be closed. Mayor Hunnicutt declared Robert Collier appointed on Ecology Committee.

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Vic Jones and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that the six other persons as named be appointed by acclamation on the Ecology Committee.

Robert Collier nominated Wright Dawson for appointment to City of Norton Planning Commission.

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Vic Jones and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that nominations be closed.

Mayor Hunnicutt declared Wright Dawson appointed as member of City of Norton Planning Commission, said term to expire July 31, 1983.

Cliff Daniels moved that Dreama Holmes be nominated as member of Community Wide Advisory Committee for four year term.

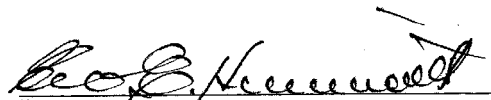
Robert Collier moved that nominations be closed.

Mayor Hunnicutt declared Dream Holmes nominated as member of Community Wide Advisory Committee for four year term.

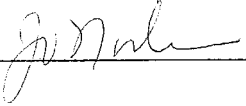
