Council discussed at length emergency water ordinance passed in 1978. No definite action taken on the ordinance as it now stands on the books.

Councilman Collier reported on meeting of Ecology Committee and requested that City contribute \$100.00 toward finances for beginning of this committee. On motion by Vic Jones, seconded by Cliff Daniels and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that City give \$100.00 to Ecology Committee, said funds to come from Contingency.

Councilman Jones inquired as to whether Council had guidelines by which they operated. Mayor Hunnicutt advised that council takes no action on individual matters that everything goes through the City Manager.

Council discussed briefly the 1979 delinquent tax list.

Mayor Hunnicutt recognized Auxilliary Police Department,

Councilman Jones told Council he thought it a good idea for the City to have a roster out front to hold peoples notes when speaking to council. Also thought the P.A. system was not working as it should. Councilman Collier stated he was going to take care of P.A. System. He also spoke on burglary alarm for school. Council discussed these matters briefly.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Vic Jones and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved to continue this council meeting until Thursday, September 18th at 7:30 P.M.
