

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on September 18, 1979, at 7:30 p.m. with Mayor Hunnicutt presiding.

Minutes of the previous meetings were read and approved.

Council briefly discussed ordinance for tax relief for elderly.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Robert Collier, and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that the following ordinance, "Providing for the Exemption of Taxes on Property of Certain Elderly Persons in the City of Norton", be passed. (Insert)

Council discussed disposition of vacated school buildings. Council agreed to advertise for bids on demolition of property, bids to be on each building separately and on both buildings together.

The City Manager presented list of surplus property requesting permission to place invitation for bids for sale of this property.

On motion by Robert Collier, seconded by Cliff Daniels, and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that the following resolution of "Appreciation by the Norton City Council, Norton, Virginia, for Assistance by the Coeburn Correctional Unit 18, Coeburn, Virginia", be passed. (Insert)

On motion by Robert Collier, seconded by Frank Fischer, and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that the following "Fair Housing Law" resolution be passed as read. (Insert)

Rosalind McGannon, representing Pro-Art Association was present and presented request that City of Norton contribute \$200.00 toward special program to be presented during December 17th-20th. This contribution would help enable all children to be able to see this program at no cost of children. Council briefly discussed this matter with Mrs. McGannon.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Robert Collier, and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that they authorize payment to Pro-Art Association in the amount of \$200.00, said fund to be taken from Contingency Fund.

Mayor Hunnicutt advised Council of letters he had received regarding Energy, meeting of Coal Policy group at Wise, October 1st.


Mayor Hunnicutt declared council back in regular session.


